Baptism (Infant) - Preparation classes offered monthly except July and December.

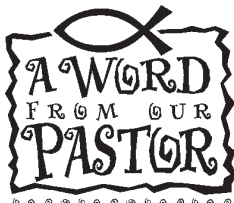

The world is saddened and shocked yet again by a report of a terrorist attack, again in France. This attack comes uncomfortably close to us as Catholics. The victim was a priest, Père Jacques Hamel. He was eighty-four years old. He continued his ministry for a full decade after the point where he might have retired. But, with the priest shortage being severe in France, he kept his "hand to the plow." Père Jacques was assassinated at the altar where he was offering Mass with a small congregation for "the good of all God's holy church." This places him in a line of holy martyrs, such as Thomas Beckett and Óscar Romero. This weekend we pray for the repose of his soul. We likewise pray for the restoration of peace in poor France and for the reconciliation of all peoples.

"What can separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril or sword? No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, for anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus, our Lord." (Romans 8:35, 37-39)

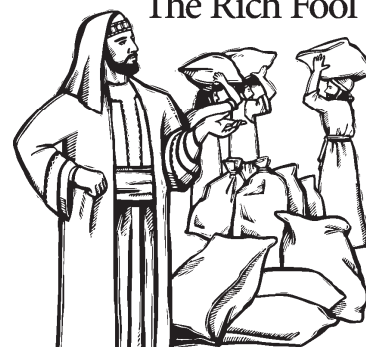


St Philomena Cookbook
