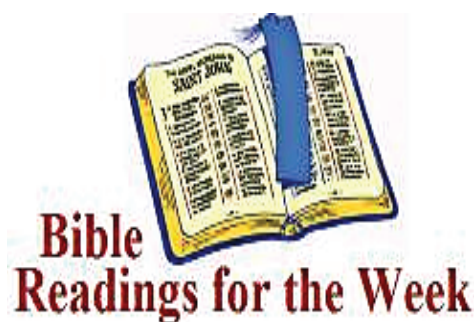

RCIC/RCIA:

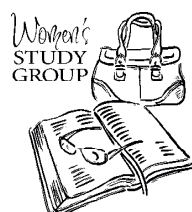
