What is the Couples for Christ Foundation for Family & Life?

Its primary work is evangelization, founded on family renewal. In this, it focuses on renewing the family and defending life, as well as participating in the work of building the Church of the Poor.

What is the Christian Life Seminar (CLS)?

The CLS is an integrated course intended to lead seminar participants into a renewed understanding of God's call to them as Christians. It runs for a total of 5 sessions. Most sessions consist of three basic ingredients: a teaching, a group discussion, and a time for fellowship.

Open House


