We accomplish this by making our presence known at the Planned Parenthood Clinic in Federal Way (on the west side of Pacific Highway, on South 348, south side of street) for four (4) consecutive Tuesdays from 9am until 3pm. We do this as a visible sign of our love and support for LIFE. During our two hour time commitments we walk and pray for a change of heart and to offer prayers for individuals who have made decisions against life. We are scheduled on the following Tuesdays: March 14, 21, 28, and April 4.

We ask for a 2 hour commitment, if possible, each of the 5 weeks, with groups of at least 2 people for each time slot. Sign-up sheets can be found on the bulletin board outside the main entrance of the Church, or you can stop by or call the office to place your name on the schedule. Please walk in the witness of our God who created us all in His image and likeness.
